## Causeway Foundation

One hundred percent of fundraised and donated dollars support Causeway Work Centre Programs, Services and Social Enterprises. It is the Foundation's goal to raise the profile of community mental health in the Ottawa region, through our quarterly newsletter, *Causeway Connection* and fundraising events.

This year, the Foundation distributed more than **\$82,000** to support Causeway's programs and social enterprises. Since 2006, the Foundation has disbursed more than **\$170,000** to the Work Centre in support of individuals with mental health issues and or disabilities.

In 2006, Causeway Foundation established an Endowment Fund at the Community Foundation of Ottawa. This fund now holds a value in excess of **\$10,000**.

The Foundation owns the building at 22 O'Meara St. that houses Causeway Work Centre programs and services. It is our mandate to maintain and improve the facility to provide a healthy and safe environment for Causeway clients.



## Causeway Work Centre

Causeway has been assisting individuals in the community for more than **31 years**, with programs promoting: employment, education and wellness.

Causeway Work Centre assists clients from the beginning of the employment process and provides support through to independence.

Causeway Work Centre assisted **875** clients last year, and created **363** employment opportunities. Causeway's Social Enterprises have employed more than **90** individuals.

Last year, Causeway Work Centre partnered with more than **10** organizations.

In December 2008, Causeway partnered with Algonquin College and the Ottawa Community Loan Fund to host a Corporate Social Responsibility Conference that featured a keynote presentation from, The Rt. Honorable Paul Martin, former Prime Minister of Canada..
